FLOODPLAIN MANAGEMENT WORKSHOP FOR ARANSAS COUNTY/ARANSAS PASS RESIDENTS

ROCKPORT, TX -- Texas Sea Grant and the Mission Aransas National Estuarine Research Reserve, in conjunction with the Town of Fulton, City of Aransas Pass, City of Rockport, City of Aransas Pass and Aransas County, are hosting a Floodplain Management Plan workshop on Thursday, June 1, from 6 – 8 pm at the Rockport Service Center, located at 2751 Hwy 35 Bypass. Similar events have been held in Rockport and Aransas Pass over the past several months.

The government entities are working closely with Texas Sea Grant in developing a floodplain management plan, which will be presented to Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) for the establishment of a community rating. The Community Rating System (CRS) is a voluntary incentive platform, under the National Flood Insurance Program, that recognizes communities for implementing floodplain management practices that exceed the Federal minimum requirements of the NFIP to provide protection from flooding.

In exchange for a community's proactive efforts to reduce flood risk, policyholders can receive reduced flood insurance premiums for buildings in the community. According to Rockport's Community Planner Amanda Torres, these reduced premiums reflect the reduced flood risk resulting from community efforts.

The workshop will consist of a review of the final draft version of the Plan's and discuss potential goals and actions for how Aransas County might address floodplain management in the future.
