POOL TO HOST TWO EVENTS PRIOR TO REOPENING

ROCKPORT, TX – Two of the Community Aquatic Center and Skate Park's most popular events – the Doggie Dunk and Halloween – are scheduled to take place before the pool's reopening on November 1.

The Doggie Dunk will be held from 10 am – 1:30 pm on Saturday, October 28. Individuals are invited to bring their dogs for a frolic and swim at the zero-depth entry children's pool, which features slides, sprays, and a maximum depth of 3 feet. The cost is \$5 per dog and \$1 per person.

An annual tradition, the Halloween celebration will take place on Wednesday, October 31 from 6 pm – 11 pm. The event features a haunted hay ride, swimming, refreshments and trick or treating. Cost is \$5 per person.

Beginning November 1, the pool will be open 9 am – 5 pm Tuesday through Saturday. Ongoing activities, including water aerobics, lap swim, water walking, swimming lessons and other programs, will resume their normal schedules. Daily, annual and off-season passes are available.

Located at 2001 Stadium Drive, the Community Aquatic & Skate Park is nestled within a 12-acre live oak forest and is open year-round. It features an 8-lane, heated, 25-yard pool and driving area, a zero-depth entry children's pool with slides and sprays, a bathhouse and a 6,000-square-foot modular skate park. Adjacent to the aquatic and skate park is a picnic area, playground and a ¼ mile nature trail.
