## COMMUNITY TO HOLD VETERANS DAY SERVICE

ROCKPORT, TX – In honor of those who have served in the United States Armed Forces, a special Veterans Day Service will be held on Monday, November 11, 2019, at 11:00 a.m. at Veterans Memorial Park on Austin Street. The event is free and open to the public.

The ceremony will include presentation and posting of the colors by the ACISD Navy Junior ROTC, recognition of local veterans' organizations and law enforcement agencies, laying of the wreath and dedication, and the presentation of the National Anthem by Rockport-Fulton High School's Band and Choir. Rockport resident LTC (U.S. ANC, Ret.) Helene Harris is the guest speaker.

Born in Chicago, IL, Helene Harris, LTC, AN (Ret), graduated from Niles North High School and enlisted in the US Army in November 1974, where she immediately trained as a Licensed Practical Nurse. She left the service in 1977 as a Specialist 5, after a successful tour at Tripler Army Medical Center in Honolulu.

Harris re-entered the US Army as a Reservist in 1978 in Birmingham, AL, where she attended Jacksonville State University and received a Bachelor of Science in Nursing in 1981.

After graduation, she was commissioned into the Army Nursing Corps on Active Duty as Second Lieutenant.

She retired as a Lieutenant Colonel.
