May 27, 2021 a new program in Texas targets more individuals that may have transportation issues. Groups of five or more people can schedule a mobile Covid-19 Vaccine clinic.

The state has set up a program that will target rural areas, homebound individuals, rural areas and senior citizens.

Here are the basics:

1. Five or more individuals
2. Any location will do: park, business, house or apartment
3. Just about any location will work and evenings and weekends will work too.

Any group of five or more Texans can schedule a vaccination site by calling 844-90-TEXAS and selecting option 3.

The State Mobile vaccine program wants to give all Texans a chance to receive the life-saving Covid-19 vaccine. The mobile vaccine teams are made up of members of the Texas National Guard and are coordinated by the Texas Division of the Emergency Management.

Recently, a group of 10 was required and that is no longer necessary. Homebound Texans are encouraged to call this same hot line and select Option 1 to request a state mobile vaccination team to visit their home.

The call center is open Monday-Saturday from 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM.
