MOTORIST ALERT: LANE SHIFT ON KEY ALLEGRO BRIDGE

ROCKPORT, TX – The City of Rockport and the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) have been notified by the contractor on the Key Allegro Bridge Construction Project, that they will be implementing a lane shift for motorists crossing the bridge. The shift will take place during the week of March 7, weather permitting.

According to City Public Works Director Mike Donoho, the shift of lane usage should cause no issues for those driving across the bridge. “We’re not making any changes to the traffic control and safety plan that were implemented last summer,” he noted. “We’re getting significantly closer to the completion of a new and greatly improved bridge for Key Allegro,” he added.

This lane shift will allow for work to begin on the second half of the bridge and when that is completed, both sides will be finished with a new smooth asphalt topping. The project is expected to be completed by late summer of 2022.
