FREE EASTER EVENT FOR AREA FAMILIES

ROCKPORT, TX – The City of Rockport is hosting a free Easter Fest event on Saturday, April 1 from 10am – Noon at Memorial Park, located at the intersection of FM 2165/Pearl Street and Enterprise.

This family event will feature arts and crafts, games, egg hunts, Touch-A-Truck, and more. A free hot dog lunch will be provided by the Parks Department, and the Easter Bunny will be making an appearance and offer photo opportunities. Activity booth sponsors include Texas Maritime Museum, Fulton Mansion, City of Rockport Municipal Court, Rockport Center for the Arts, City of Rockport Finance Department, Rockport Martial Arts & Fitness, Allwyn Dental, City of Rockport Public Works, and the Rockport Fulton Community Pool. The Touch-A-Truck portion of the event will offer children a hands-on opportunity to explore working trucks of all types, as well as meet the people who build, protect, and serve the Rockport community.
