## **\*\* NOTICE \*\***

**Effective March 12, 2024**

**The City of Rockport is currently in mandatory Stage 2 water restriction.**

**Restrictions are as follows:**

- Mandatory Compliance
- Watering prohibited 10am-6pm
- Irrigation allowed any day, with a handheld hose (with a positive shutoff nozzle), faucet-filled bucket, watering can (<5 gals.), or drip irrigation with a positive shutoff device
- Every other week watering using a hose-end sprinkler or automatic irrigation system<sup>°</sup>
- New landscaping may be watered for up to 60 days within appropriate water times & is not restricted to once a week
- Washing vehicles on premises on designated water schedule allowed<sup>°</sup>
- Refilling of pools & Jacuzzis on designated water schedule allowed<sup>°</sup>
- Use of water to maintain the integrity of a building foundation allowed<sup>°</sup>

### **Watering Schedule**

- Tuesday – Even numbered houses
- Wednesday – Odd numbered houses
- Thursday - Multifamily and Commercial

*<sup>°</sup>The Drought Contingency Plan does not apply to irrigation systems using private water wells or aerobic septic systems; however, properties using such systems must post a prominent, legible sign stating "Water Well". Please see the Drought Contingency Plan for additional details on triggers, targets, authorized or prohibited uses, and penalties.*
