SEVERE WEATHER UPDATE FOR

JUNE 20, 2024 AT 1:00 P.M.

ROCKPORT, TX – Tropical Storm Alberto made landfall in Mexico late last night. Although the Tropical Storm has passed, we will continue to receive scattered showers throughout the day Thursday and into Friday and possibly into the weekend. High Tides continue to cause Street Flooding in low lying areas with waves coming over the roads along Bay facing areas. We will continue to monitor forecasts for updates and alerts as they occur.

Below is a list of streets that remain closed due to flooding. Drivers SHOULD NOT attempt to drive in these areas unless it is absolutely necessary. If you must, please drive slowly as to not cause further damage by pushing water & debris into homes or businesses.
