HURRICANE BERYL UPDATE No. 3

ARANSAS COUNTY, TEXAS: All visitors, special needs residents, and residents in low-lying or flood-prone areas of Aransas County are now under a Voluntary Evacuation Order. The Voluntary Evacuation Order also includes owners of high-profile vehicles such as RVs, boats, and large vehicles, which are particularly vulnerable to high winds. These persons and vehicles should strive to be moved out of the affected areas by 5 P.M. on Saturday, July 6th.

A phased or controlled exit of visitors and residents in low-lying or flood-prone areas from Aransas County is strongly advised to ensure that the roadways are clear for public evacuation should a more urgent evacuation order be issued in the near future.

In preparation for Hurricane Beryl's predicted landfall, all visitors and residents are advised that there are NO emergency shelter facilities in Aransas County. Sheltering in place is not advised for residents in low-lying or flood-prone areas.

All visitors and residents are hereby advised that medical and emergency services will likely be affected by the effects of the predicted landfall of Hurricane Beryl, which include strong winds and possible power outages.
